AWARDED TO JELCC SENIORS WHO DEMONSTRATE:

- Ability to persevere through challenges and problem-solve.
- Service to others, possess a positive attitude, and shows acceptance of all.
- Clear communication.
- Ability to be a self-starter and critical thinker.
- Reliability, responsibility and teamwork.
- Organization skills, importance of punctuality and selfmanagement.

- Academic readiness: possessing a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher and has met or is on track to meet all graduation requirements.
- Attendance rate that is 98% or higher AND has four or fewer sign-ins, sign-outs or times tardy to school during the eligible school year.
- Earns 1 or fewer discipline referrals during the eligible school year.
- Completes a minimum of 6 hours of school or community service during the eligible school year, for which s/he has not received academic credit or compensation.
